TATA GLOBAL BEVERAGES LIMITED: POSITIONAL CALL

OBSERVATION:

- After a sharp and consistent upsurge from Mid-November 2016 to Mid-January 2018, the stock of Tata Global Beverages formed a Double top on January 12th and January 19th week at 328 levels;
- Since then the stock has been trading with lower tops and lower bottoms till date. With this the stock has corrected up to 61.8% retracement of the entire upside move from 100 to 285 levels;
- Within the lower tops and lower bottom pattern, the stock has formed a Falling Wedge pattern which is seen prominently from August 2018;
- The making of the pattern was well supported by volumes. However, Since August 2018, the 14-period RSI on the daily time frame is seen trading in a range of 30 to 55-60, depicting a kind of positive divergence between prices and RSI;
- Recently the stock gave a Falling Wedge pattern breakout at 203 levels with justifiable volumes and 14-period RSI breakout quoting above 61;
- The 13-34-55 EMA lines too were quoting more or less same at equal distance from each other at the start of March 2019 followed by 13-34 positive crossover on March 13, 2019.

ACTION:

Tata Global Beverages Limited - **BUY** in the scrip at **209** levels with a downside of up to **205** for a Target of **225** followed by **240** and with a Stop loss of **193**.
